Apprentice Program

Once an individual is in possession of a Sponsorship Letter and has all the necessary documentation, they will be scheduled by our Apprentice Coordinator to go through the application process. This includes an aptitude test, interview and a drug screen. We do find that applicants struggle with the aptitude test, which is strictly mathematics, and recommend seeking out an effective way to prepare yourself before you arrive at the Training Center. We have compiled a list that you may find useful.

Helpful Hints:

The aptitude test consist of a basic math test which includes addition, subtraction, multiplication, division, fractions and percentages. You may find study guides at your local library or on the internet; YouTube or Google are great sources.

Interview Process:

- Be on time
- Good posture and eye contact
- Familiarize yourself with the job in which you are applying
- Dress appropriately; work clothes
- Be prepared to discuss why you want to enter into this trade
- Turn off your phone
- Be prepared to ask questions
